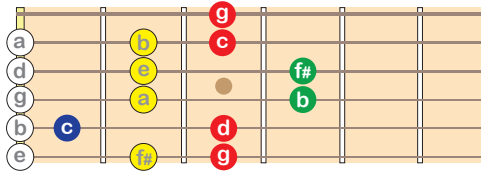
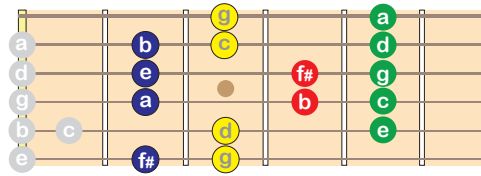


G major scale
position 1

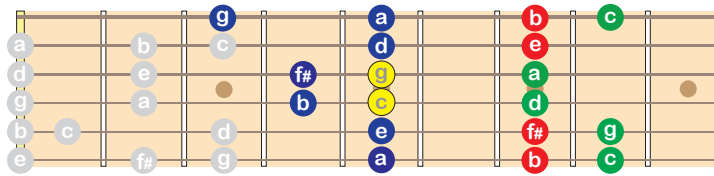

- open (a note played at the nut)

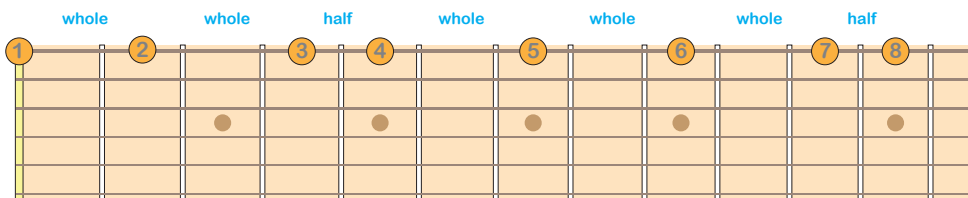
G major scale
